The Playground - Waterbeach, Cambridge - Thursday 23 October 2025

We are pleased to tell you that a curriculum trip has been arranged for Year 7 to visit The Playground, at Waterbeach in Cambridgeshire.

Students will take part in a team building activity. There are 30 obstacles over a 1km course where they will work in teams to reach the finish line. They will also play a number of games including: Tug O'War; Tractor Tyre Flips; Giant Noughts & Crosses; Car Tyre Course Challenge; Muddy Ditch Relays. The trip will be physically, mentally and emotionally challenging. Students will need to bring a packed lunch and change of clothes. Please do not allow your child to wear their best shoes or clothes for the course - it will be muddy!

This trip will take place during the school day, arriving back to Smithdon by 3pm.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals and would like a packed lunch provided by the canteen, please indicate this on the online Google form below.

The cost of the trip is £32 per student.
