Explore composing film music while looking at key techniques like leitmotifs, mood, etc. Will also explore key composers




Singing – 3-part harmony The Blues - it's history and performing a piece of blues music




Notation and Keyboard skills part 2. Chord inversions and moving the hand around the keyboard smoothly



Notation and Keyboard skills part 2. The bass clef. Chords and tonality and link to mood




