What is a Knowledge Organiser?

- The Knowledge Organiser contains the core knowledge students need to learn in all subjects for a term.
- A new Knowledge Organiser will be provided each term.
- Learning everything contained in the Knowledge organiser will help with lessons and assessments.
- Ultimately it will help students become independent learners and help develop revision techniques needed in later schooling.

How to use the Knowledge Organiser:

Every school day, students should aim to study 1 to 2 subjects from the booklet

- During this term students are being taught techniques for how to use the Knowledge Organiser to help them: these can be found at the front of the booklet.
- Please encourage your child to complete their homework and reading logs, giving them to you to sign each week - they get rewarded for this!
- Students should have their booklet with them every day. If they lose it, a new one can be purchased from the school shop for £1 or printed from the website. (All Knowledge Organisers should be retained!)

Google Classroom:

 This is used to post messages, share information and set knowledge organiser tasks.

 Parents will have been sent a link from their child's form tutor in Year 7 to "join".

 You will receive a weekly email of activities (or if you set up a Google account, you can choose to receive a daily email)

 Encourage your child to check both their emails and google classrooms daily.

Parent App:

 This can be used to give you up to date information about reward points and consequence points.

You can view your child's timetable.

You can view your child's attendance.
