This last year has been extremely hard for everyone due to the unprecedented times with Covid 19. However, it is thanks to organisations like the NHS and research laboratories that we have various vaccines and treatments to reduce the chance of serious illness from the virus.

All Health and Social Care departments in the West Norfolk Academies Trust have teamed up with the Queen Elizabeth Hospital in King's Lynn. They informed us that at the height of the pandemic they had 220 Covid 19 inpatients in their care. After speaking to the hospital staff, this is just a few comments of what they had to say:-

As a way of saying thank you to those front line workers, we are hoping to raise funds on an annual basis for the Queen Elizabeth Hospital. This year we want to raise money for the Covid 19 fund to help support the hospital staff and patients. Staff mentioned how important their wellbeing and mental health is to them and would appreciate some benches outside to allow them to refresh and try to relax during their breaks.

When faced with illnesses such as Covid 19 it is important that we all stay fit and healthy, and exercise is one way to do this. Exercise helps our body, our mind and our soul.

Therefore, all students and staff in the West Norfolk Academies Trust Schools and staff at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital are invited to take part in a Fun Run on Friday 9 July 2021.
