We have an exciting opportunity for your son/daughter to take part in a Year 7 Maths Enrichment day at the University of East Anglia, Norwich, on Tuesday 26 March 2024.

This will involve a day of mathematical activities – exploring games and puzzles with the opportunity for students to meet with enthusiasts of their own age. It will also give students the opportunity to investigate the maths of games, to inspire students to want to choose to study maths after GCSE and improve their problem-solving skills using recreational maths. Ultimately, we hope they just have fun!
