GCSE Results Day - Thursday 21 August 2025

Examinations results will be available for you to collect in person on Thursday 21 August 2025, from the main hall. The time that your results will be available will be based on surnames as follows: -

8.30am	A to B
8.45am	C to F
9am	G to I
9.15am	J to M
9.30am	N to S
9.45am	T to Z

On arrival in the Results Day Celebration Area, you will be able to collect your results and have a photograph with your parents, before speaking to the post-16 providers, Springwood and the College of West Anglia, who will be here to answer any questions you may have.

If you are unable to come into school and you want any other person (including family members) to collect your results on your behalf, you must inform the school of your intention before results day and complete the Results Collection Request form available on our school website (under 'Exam/Revision Info'). This form must be handed in by the person you have authorised to collect your results on Thursday 21 August, along with the documentation requested on the form.

If you do not collect your results in person, or complete the Results Collection Request process, your results will be sent to you by recorded delivery via Royal Mail.

We would really love to share in the celebration of your success and hope that you will be able to join us. You are welcome to bring along family members.

If you still have books belonging to the school, please return these as soon as possible so that they can be redistributed to Year 10 students.
