Email

Primarily email is used to send out the vast majority of letters from the school, as well as important notices and information. Email can also be used to contact Form Tutors directly.

If you would like to add or update an email address, you can do this on the MCAS App (see below)

Text Messages

Text messages are used to send urgent messages to parents, including cancellation of/changes to any after school events, and reminders.

The MyChildAtSchool (MCAS) App

The MCAS App can be used to view your child's timetable and attendance record for the academic year. You can also use the MCAS App to view all your child's rewards and consequences (behaviour) entries.

Twice-yearly academic reports are uploaded to the MCAS App for parents.

Basic details (name/address/telephone number/email address/image consent) can also be updated through the MCAS App.

The MCAS App is available for all parents/carers with Parental Responsibility.

The Smithdonian Magazine

The magazine is created every term, with information about individual successes, recent events in school and department activities. A link is emailed to parents and placed on the school's website.
