Places on this trip are limited, therefore a place on this trip is subject to high levels of attendance, excellent punctuality and no behavioural incidents prior to the trip. Please note that, at the discretion of the Senior Leadership Team, places can be withdrawn if students fail to meet the criteria for this rewards trip.

The cost of the trip is £27.00 which includes transport by coach and admission fees (this is nonrefundable unless a suitable replacement is found). Further remittance advice can be found on the school website and parents are encouraged to refer to this.

Students should be at school at normal time on Friday 18 July for an 8.45am departure. We will leave Pleasurewood Hills at 3pm and return to school by approximately 5pm.

Students can wear non-school uniform and depending on the weather may need a waterproof coat or sunhat and sun cream. Students can either bring a packed lunch or buy refreshments in the park. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and would like a packed lunch provided by the canteen, please indicate this on the consent form below.
